THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF DUNDALK

BY-LAW NUMBER 1040

BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE DUNDALK TOWN HALL

WHEREAS The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O., 1980, Chapter 337, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including the buildings and structures thereon, to be of historic or architectural value or interest:

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Dundalk has caused to be served upon the owner of the lands and premises known as The Dundalk Town Hail and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS the reasons for designation are set out in Schedule "B" thereto:

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;
THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE
OF DUNDALK ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) THAT the real property known municipally as The Dundalk Town Hall, more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto is designated as being of historical and architectural interest.
- 2) THAT the Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper registry office.
- 3) THAT the Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be engrossed in the by-Law Book of the Corporation and a copy to be served on the Ontairo Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 21st day of May ,1987.
