## Zoning amendment process

**Purpose:** a zoning by-law amendment is required to change a zone symbol on a property to permit expanded or different land uses on a specific property. A zoning by-law amendment may also be requested to change a zone provision (setback or similar regulation) or general provision.

**Process:** Discuss your proposal with the municipal planning department prior to submitting your application. Make your application to the planning department along with the required fee. A planning staff report will be prepared and a public meeting will be set. The applicant will be advised of the time and date of this meeting and invited to make representation at this time in order to explain why the zoning amendment request is being made.

You can expect a decision on your application within 150 days. This time is used to review the application, set up a public meeting, post the required public notice, draft a zoning by-law amendment and ensure that all other required documentation is in order.

At least 20 days prior to the public meeting, notice of the public meeting is either sent to every assessed property within 120 metres (400 feet) of the subject property or a notice is placed in the appropriate local newspaper. The applicant or a representative must attend the public meeting to explain why the zoning amendment is required to members of the Council and the public, as well as answer any questions that may arise.

A site plan and agreement may be required to be negotiated prior to any further proceedings of the rezoning process. Following the public meeting and if Council is satisfied with the application, an amending by-law will be considered by Council. Should the by-law be passed, a notice of passing is prepared and sent to everyone on the first mailing list or published in the newspaper. A 20 day appeal period is required to be included in this notice to allow anyone to appeal the by-law to the Ontario Municipal Board.

Should your application not be approved by Council, you also have the right to appeal to the Local Planning Appeals Tribunal within the same 20 day appeal period. If the application is approved and no appeal is filed, a notice of no appeal is prepared and sent to the applicant at which time the process is now completed. A building permit would not be available for any works associated with the by-law until the appeal period has passed and if no appeals were filed.

#### Zoning by-law amendment process summary

- 1. Pre-consultation (required by By-law 66-2012)
- Submit application
- Clerk sets a public meeting Notice sent to neighbours within 120 metres (400 feet) and various agencies, 20 days prior to public meeting.
- Public meeting
   Applicant and/or agent should attend to resolve any potential concerns.
   Council will consider the proposal and may pass a by-law that meeting.
- Appeal period
   After a Notice of Passing for the by-law amendment is sent to neighbours within 120 metres (400 feet) and agencies, 20 day appeal period begins.
- 6. Decision final
  If not appeal is filed with the Township within the appeal period, the process
  is complete and the zoning by-law amendment is in full force and effect.
