In the follow-up to the Member 2022 the Member bylaws were include two (2) revisions.		

4.03 Election and Number of Directors

The number of directors shall be fifteen (15), unless changed by special resolution or otherwise in accordance with the Act.
Directors shall be elected at a meeting of members on a show of hands unless a poll is demanded, in which case such election shall be by ballot. Retiring directors shall continue in office until their successors have been duly elected or appointed.

May 27, 2022 - OAPSB Membership, hereby authorizes By-law Number 1-Section 4.03 be amended to increase the number of directors from fifteen (15) to seventeen (17) directors. One candidate from the North-Zones 1/1A (commencing 2022) and one indigenous candidate at large originating from a First Nations Board (commencing 2023)

4.04 Nomination of Directors

Not less than forty-five (45) days prior to the annual meeting of members, each of the following shall notify the Board of its nominee or nominees for election to the board at such annual meeting:

- (i) Each Zone shall submit one nominee;
- (ii) The Big 12 (excluding Toronto) shall submit four (4) nominees; and
- (iii) The Toronto Police Services Board each shall submit one nominee.

At each such annual meeting, the representatives of the Police Services Boards operating pursuant to Section 10 of the PSA shall select and advise of three (3) nominees, one (1) selected by such Boards in Zones 1 and 1A, one(1) selected by such Boards in Zones 2 and 3 and one(1) selected by such Boards in Zones 4, 5 and 6.

May 27, 2022 - that the OAPSB Membership hereby authorizes By-Law Number 1-Section 4.05 be amended to increase the term of office from a one (1) year to a three (3) year term, at the beginning of the 2023 terms of Directors.
